The Fine Print

1. All Commissioners must commit to completing online training for their position as listed on ScoutingU and to complete said training within the timeframe recommended on ScoutingU, to attend some Commissioners' Meetings, and to recruit a replacement before leaving their position. (Technology-based meetings are being considered.)
2. Unit Commissioners must commit to making and recording at least 6 Unit Contacts, at least 3 of which must be in person, and to complete and record at least one Unit Assessment. Additional Unit Contacts and Detailed Assessments are encouraged.
3. Roundtable Commissioners must commit to planning and presenting 10 Roundtables or Breakouts each calendar year. Positions include Assistant District Commissioner for Roundtable, Boy Scout Roundtable Commissioner, & Assistant Roundtable Commissioners.
4. Various Assistant District Commissioner (ADC) positions are available including ADC for Unit Commissioners in Clallam County, ADC for Unit Commissioners in East Jefferson County, ADC for Roundtable, and ADC for Recruiting.
5. Purchase—Make an open-ended commitment. Lease—Make a minimum one year commitment. Ride-Share—Share the position with someone else. (Primarily applicable to Roundtable Commissioners but may be considered for other positions).
6. Your mileage may vary. Taxes, license, delivery, document, and dealer preparation fees not included.
